These roles contributed to the achievement of departmental mandates and improved organisational performance based on the Strategic Plans, Annual Performance Plans, Operational Plans, and Business Plans.

ADDG Libago has a Masters Degree in Public Development Management from the University of Witwatersrand, a Post-Graduate Diploma in Monitoring and Evaluation from the University of Stellenbosch, an Honours Degree in Social Sciences from the University of Pretoria, a Bachelor of Arts Degree, and a Higher Education Diploma from the University of Limpopo, as well as several certificates from UNISA, University of Stellenbosch, and University of Cape Town.
